Players Code of Conduct

We expect all our players to train and play to the best of their ability and always show the upmost respect to coaches, team mates, opposing players and officials.

- Always train and play to the best of my ability and for the benefit of my team.
- Play fairly – I won't cheat, dive, complain or waste time.
- Always exhibit good sportsmanship and show respect to all opposing players, spectators, parents, coaches and team mates.
- Play by the rules of the game, as directed by the referee.
- Be gracious in victory and defeat – players will shake/fist bump opposing players and officials
- Players must listen and respond to what their coaches say to them.
- Players must respect the coach making decisions and understand they must do what's best for the team not the individual.
- Players will accept responsibility for their behaviour and work with coaches to resolve it.
- Players must adhere to our bullying guidelines set out.
- Offensive, abusive, or insulting remarks made towards any player, coach, official, or parent will be dealt with resulting consequences.
- Players must raise any concerns to their coach or someone they trust if they are unhappy about anything
- Players must not enter our training facilities until they have been asked to by our coaches.
- Players wear the correct suitable kit to both training and matches.

If breaking the above code of conduct, I may:

Be required to apologise to my team mates, the other team, referee or team managers.

- Receive a warning about my behaviour.
- Be asked not to play in the game due to my behaviour.
- Be suspended for a period from training and matches.
- Be required to leave with immediate effect.
