We have taken enhanced health and safety measures for you, your child and our other children/parents by adhering to the FA and Department of DCMS guidelines.

You must follow all posted instructions whilst visiting Elite Development Soccer Schools

- An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease which poses possible illness to all.
- By your child attending Elite Development Soccer Schools you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19.
- In the event that your child is sent home with suspected symptoms of COVID-19 or in the bubble of a suspected COVID-19 case then a credit note for the loss of sessions will be issued at our discretion (No refunds will be given).
- Help keep each other healthy by adhering to the guidelines.

COVID Safe Agreement



- All sessions will have 2 metre or 1 metre plus social distancing
- All parents or guardians are to drop the player off at a designated meeting point where the coach will take the player to the soccer school which will be the only coach designated to that group
- Parents & guardians are unable to attend the session and have to drop off and collect from their designated points
- All players are asked to hand sanitize their hands before and after each session throughout the day along with break and lunch times.
- All equipment that comes into contact is disinfected after each session
- Any player feeling unwell will be asked not to train
- Any player that fails our temperature check will be omitted from the rest of the course
- Any 2 players that fail our temperature check they along with all in their bubble including the coach will be omitted from the course and asked to self isolate for 7 days.
- If any member of your household is also feeling unwell, we will ask you to self-isolate for 7 days All sessions that wish to be cancelled for any other reason after payment has been made is non refundable
- If you are unable to provide hand sanitizer, we will also have supplies of this available to use but we recommend bringing your own to each day which will needs to be labelled with the players name on
- All children are recommended to wear goalkeeper gloves for the duration of the session as an added protection
- Toilets will be designated to each bubble and cleaned throughout the day
- All parents have to sign the declaration for their son/daughter to attend these sessions.

- It is vital we stick to the assessments carried out by us for all 3 days of each course
- All children will remain in the same social bubble for the whole duration of each course with the same coach
- These bubbles will not mix at any point throughout the day
- We have strict timelines in place so we stagger lunch and break times
- First Aid to follow strict protocol when applying treatment to any player throughout the duration of this course
- Laces will be tied up for our younger players but both will ask to sanitize straight after and have shoes sprayed with disinfectant immediately after



What to expect?

We pride ourselves on delivering fun safe courses that children can thrive learning in and leave knowing they have had a good day. This does not change with our Summer 2020 courses, but we will follow strict protocols to ensure the safety of all players, parents and staff is of the highest order.

Our registration zones will be used for any breaks through staggered times throughout the day with rigorous cleaning in place. These areas will also only be used in extreme weather conditions where they will be still in their bubbles of their designated area.

We hope you appreciate the measures we have put in place and that all children will still have the most enjoyable experience with us this summer.



Children Expectations

- All children such have their own water bottle, hand sanitizer, packed lunch suitable clothing and have it labelled with their name on it
- All children must adhere to the 2M or 1M plus social distancing
- Children should wash their hands as frequent as possible and avoid touching their face
- Children must follow the catch it, bin it, kill it protocol when coughing and sneezing
- If you feel unwell you must not attend even if you wish too
- Spitting is strictly banned



Parent Expectations

- All parents are only permitted to drop off and collect the child.

 Watching will not be allowed so we can minimize numbers congregating around the venue
- We are asking all parents also hand sanitize before collecting and picking up along with following protocol of not collecting if feeling unwell
- We require ALL parents to monitor their child's health both pre and post session and insure they DO NOT ATTEND if feeling unwell.
- Ensure your child has enough fluids for the day as we are unable to provide water facilities for drinks
- If a child gets sent home and develops further symptoms its your duty to contact us so we can refer all children from the bubble and they may be referred to the track and trace set out by government
- All other children will also be notified of this also
- Wash kit everyday



Coaches Expectations

- Coaches do not need to use new footballs or equipment for each lesson but will clean them at the start, middle and end of the day
- All sessions will be designed around social distance training and players will be asked not to pick up the balls throughout unless wearing GK gloves
- Coaches are to closely monitor and deliver all expectations of the risk assessments set out
- Coaches are not allowed to leave the venue at anytime and will bring everything required for the day with them
- If a coach develops COVID-19 symptoms they will be dismissed from coaching



Pick up & Drop off Points

- All children will have their temperature checked upon arrival by our host coach who will be wearing PPE
- Children will be given a coloured registration point where they will enter for drop off
- All children will have their very own marked area to use through registration, breaks & lunch
- The drop off zones will be divided into 3 sections for each bubble
- Pick up points will be given on registration and will remain the same colour for each bubble
- Parents must follow all social distancing measures when picking up and dropping off
- We will be unable to accept any child who is late for their registration time
